## STUDENT FEES 2011-2012

### MANDATORY FEES

#### All School Levels

- Elementary textbook/instructional materials fee \$45.00
- Middle school textbook/instructional materials fee \$45.00
- High school textbook/instructional materials fee \$30.00

Purpose – To recover part of the cost of provided textbooks and materials for core classes (e.g. refills for Foss Science Kits, Everyday Math Journals, math manipulatives, independent reading libraries, guided reading books, classroom consumables, subscriptions, and other material costs) Families who present Free & Reduced meal eligibility letters are exempt.

#### High School and Middle School Level

- High School Technology Fee \$10.00
- Middle School Technology Fee \$15.00

Purpose – To assist with the cost of providing technology services.

### OPTIONAL FEES (required for participation)

#### All School Levels

- Transportation Fee \$15.00 per month

Purpose – To defray excess transportation costs. Family discount available (after 2 paid riders). Families who present Free & Reduced meal eligibility letters are exempt. Families bussed for Title I Choice are exempt. Other exemptions may apply.

- Textbook Replacement Full Replacement Cost
- Library Book Replacement Full Replacement Cost

Purpose – To recover the cost of lost or damaged textbooks and/or library books.

- Field Trips Cost of Field Trip

Purpose – To provide curriculum enrichment, and to recover part of the cost for transportation and the cost for admission, as applicable.

#### Middle School Level

- Replacement ID/Cover/Lanyard \$5.00
- Replacement Student Agenda/Planner \$5.00
- Yearbook Cost of Yearbook

Purpose – To cover the cost of lost or damaged items. To cover the cost of providing students with a yearbook.

- PE Shirt/Shorts/Uniform Cost of clothing

Purpose – To cover the cost of clothing for PE classes.

Purpose – To cover the cost of expendable or consumable supplies and materials for classes (e.g. rental of bowling alley, rental of special equipment, and training materials).

- Science
  - Chemistry/CP Chemistry \$10.00 (for goggles, lab books, software, consumables)
  - Anatomy/Phys \$10.00 (for goggles)
- World Language \$15.00 (if workbook is required)

Purpose – To cover the cost of expendable or consumable supplies and materials for classes (e.g. goggles, lab books, software, workbooks, and consumables).

## Continued: OPTIONAL FEES (required for participation)

### High School Level

- AP Courses Determined by College Board

Purpose – To cover the cost of Advanced Placement assessments taken by student. A late fee may be assessed in addition to the registration fee as determined by College Board policy. Fee set for 2011-12 is \$89.00

- IB Exams Determined by IBO ( International Baccalaureate Organization)

Purpose – To cover the cost of IB assessments taken by students. These fees include a one-time registration fee and subject assessment fees. A late fee may be assessed in addition to the registration and per subject fee as determined by IBO policy

- Replacement ID/Cover/Lanyard \$5.00

Purpose – To cover the cost of lost or damaged items.

- Student Agenda/Planner \$5.00
- Locker Fee \$2.00
- Yearbook Cost of Yearbook
- Parking Permit \$50.00

Purpose – To cover the cost of items and/or to cover the cost of programs and accompanying expenses such as maintenance and workers.

- Activity Sticker \$30.00

Purpose – To provide and encourage participation in school activities.

- Co-Curricular Yearly fees set by organization
  - DECA (dues/State/National)
  - FBLA (dues/State/National/Local)
  - FCCLA (dues/State/National/Local)
  - Musical Production (costumes, set, construction materials, royalties)
  - National Honor Society

Purpose – To provide curriculum enrichment and cover the dues of the organization associated with classes such as entrepreneurship, and business, management, and marketing.

- Athletic Fee \$115.00 for 1 sport, \$230.00 for 2 or 3 sports

Purpose – To recover part of the cost of coaches, referees, game-workers, uniforms, supplies and transportation associated with providing high school sports.
