Tuition Information: District 12 High School Student tuition is \$150 **per class**. A District 12 student is defined as having attended a District 12 school during the 20010-2011 school year. If a student lives in the District 12 attendance area but does not attend a District 12 school, the student is considered an Out of District student. Out of District High School tuition is \$200 **per class** (pending space availability). A \$50 **non-refundable** processing fee will be charged for all dropped classes. **NO refunds will be given after June 20, 2010. Students will not be enrolled in any classes until tuition has been paid in full and all registration paperwork has been completed and submitted.** Registration fees may be paid using cash, check, or money order, at the time of registration. All checks should be made to **Adams 12 Schools**.

Transportation: School bus transportation is available from all district middle schools (except Thornton Middle School) for a fee of \$45 per session. Please include transportation fee with tuition payment if applicable.

Grading/Credit Information: All high school classes will be PASS "P" or UNPASS "U". Students must earn at least 70% to earn a PASS. Credit will only be awarded for courses PASSED. If a summer school course is PASSED "P", the F will be replaced by a NM if the following two criteria are met: The course titles match the Adams 12 summer school offering and the high school transcribed class. Transcribed grades from high schools outside of Adams 12 will not be altered.

Summer School Attendance Policy: The summer school day contains 3 "periods". Any tardiness (up to 10 minutes) or absence from a period will be noted. Once a student reaches 3 class periods with a tardy or absence, parent and student will be notified. Upon the 5th class period with a tardy or absence, the student will be withdrawn for the course with an UNPASS and NO refund will be given. In extreme situations, students may make up time for up to 2 class periods. Make up time will only be accepted with prior administrative approval, and court or doctor documentation. No class time make up will be allowed for athletic practice, family vacation, camps, weddings, etc. All absences must be reported to the summer school office (720) 972-4172 by 10:00 am the day of the absence.

Pre-Registration: High School students may pre-register through their high school counselor. All registrations submitted by May 13, 2011 will be given a \$10 discount. Payment, **transcript**, and forms must be submitted together to the book keeper's office. Registration completed after May 13 must be done at walk in registration on June 13, 2011 at Thornton High School.

Walk-In Registration: Look for the **SUMMER SCHOOL** signs- **DO NOT attempt to register at the Thornton HS main office.**

THERE WILL BE NO REGISTRATION FOR CLASSES AFTER 8:00 PM JUNE 13, 2011. Students are highly encouraged to pre-register.
