

## Behavior Support Team

---

The Behavior Support Team provides the following support services and resources:

- Training—Behavior specialists will provide trainings for classroom teachers, administration, paraprofessionals, and related service providers on Functional Behavioral Assessments, Behavior Intervention Plans, crisis management, data collection and analysis.
- Consultation—Behavior specialists will work with school-based teams, individual staff members, etc. in observations, reviewing of records, attending meetings and staffings. Behavior specialists will assist in assessment necessary for Functional Behavioral Assessments, and with the implementation of Behavior Intervention Plans, data collection, and data analysis of individual students, classrooms, or schools.
- Facilitation—Behavior specialists will assist in planning of meetings with school-based teams dealing with systems, assessments, and problem solving. Behavior specialists will facilitate planning trainings of bus drivers, paraeducators, classroom teachers, Problem Solving Teams, special education teams, and will provide CPI training to appropriate provider groups.
- Evaluation—Behavior specialists will assist in evaluating the effectiveness of individual behavior intervention plans, training sessions, and other CDE directed assignments.
- Collaboration—Behavior specialists will collaborate with other district members, community services, outside providers, school based teams, and Problem Solving Teams.
