Senior Citizen REBATE PROGRAM





We value volunteers in our district, especially senior citizens who bring a wealth of experience and knowledge for the benefit of multiple generations. Adams 12 Five Star Schools Senior Citizen Rebate Program provides opportunities for men and women over the age of 60 to earn a rebate by volunteering in our schools.

If you're interested in participating in the Senior Citizen Rebate Program for Adams 12 Five Star Schools, here are some things you should know:

- Must be at least 60 years of age and own property in Adams County. You will need to provide copies of your most recent property tax bill and your driver's license.
- Most volunteer opportunities are in our elementary schools during school hours working with students. Although we try to accommodate requests for specific duties and schools, our number one priority is to support school needs.
- You will be paid accordingly for hours worked up to a maximum of 76 hours per school year at the hourly minimum wage in place at the start of the school year. You may continue volunteering without compensation after completing 76 hours.
- Payment is made in the form check mailed to your residence. The rebate check is funneled through the Adams County Treasurer's Office. They will send a check in the amount of your rebate directly to you after the close of the school year.
- We ask that you volunteer 1-3 hours per day, 2-3 days per week. Please do not expect to complete your hours within the first week or two.
- You will be working under the direction of a teacher or other staff member. They will advise you of any rules or requirements specific to the individual school. You will keep track of your hours on calendars provided to you.
- A free background check using Raptor, an online check against the National Sex Offender database, will be run on all applicants.
- We welcome you to continue volunteering for as long as you'd like. However, if you're inactive for over a year we will ask you to reapply.
