(Check website to make sure on dates.) -Student must be 17 to enroll. -Most work is done online with some classwork. -Student can earn a traditional diploma or a Competency Based Diploma (student must pass 8 WorkKeys tests & 3 courses). -School session starts every 6 weeks -known as a hexter. -School day is around 4½ hours long. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Student must complete at least one semester of highschool. -Student must complete application, interview and orientation. -School starts and enrolls every quarter. -Student must take and pass the Discovery program (to enhance social skills) prior to enrolling in Academic classes. -Has strict attendance policy. -Provides more educational and emotional support for each individual student. -Smaller school setting 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Student will finish program with a high school diploma and about 28 college credits. -Student must be 16. -Student should have at least 6 high school credits. -Student must have a high motivation to succeed in a college setting. -All classes are held at Front Range Community College. -Tuition and books are paid for. -Students are responsible for student fees but can apply for financial assistance. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Student must enroll in GED program with Adams County Workforce Center. -Program provides free GED prep classes and Free GED testing. -Program provides other resources such as work experience(s), career exploration, internship opportunities and job readiness. -Student can earn a high school diploma if requested. -Student can get help with transportation.
