Key Takeaways

1) Roughly **70% of all respondents** favor a change to bell schedules for the 2020-21 school year.

When asked to identify their most preferred scenario:

- Scenario 1= **22%** preferred
- Scenario 2= **11%** preferred

- Scenario 4= **14%** preferred

2) Roughly **63% of high school students** favor a change to bell schedules for the 2020-21 school year.
