

STUDENT RESIDENCY

- 1.0 A child shall be deemed to reside in the District if:
 - 1.1 The child's parents, or the survivor of them, reside in the District, or the one of them with whom such child resides a majority of the time pursuant to a court order resides in the District;
 - 1.2 The legally appointed guardian of the child resides in the District. A "legally appointed guardian" shall include a person to whom guardianship has been transferred in accordance with state law or who has completed the District's limited guardianship form attached as Exhibit A;
 - 1.3 The child has been emancipated by his or her parents, lives in the District, and has no guardian. A child may be deemed emancipated based upon failure of the parents to provide financial support to the child, coupled with evidence that the child is independently able to meet his/her own financial obligations.
 - 1.4 The child has been abandoned by his or her parents and lives in the District;
 - 1.5 The child has become permanently dependent for his maintenance and support on someone other than his or her parents and makes his or her home and receives his or her support within the District;
 - 1.6 Regardless of the residency of the parents, if any, the child adopts a dwelling place within the District intending to remain there indefinitely and not to return to the dwelling place from which he or she came, and regularly eats or sleeps there, or both, during the entire school year. A child shall be deemed to not have the necessary intent if he or she regularly returns to another dwelling place during vacations or weekends;
 - 1.7 If one of the child's parents/guardians is a public officer or employee living temporarily for the performance of his/her duties in the District rather than in the school district of his or her residence;
 - 1.8 If the child's parents, or the survivor of them, cannot provide proof (in their own name) of home ownership or home/apartment rental within the established school or district attendance boundaries, and has completed a declaration of residence form (Exhibit) at the time of registration or address change. The declaration of residence shall be valid for all grades served by the school;
 - 1.9 The child is homeless, or became homeless during a period that school is not in session and remains homeless, and the child presently seeks shelter or is located in the District, unless the child attended school in another school district at the time the child became homeless, or immediately prior to becoming homeless, the child remains homeless, and the District finds that attendance in such other school district is in the best interests of the child, and the child chooses to continue attendance in such other school district.
- 2.0 A student may appeal denial of residency status to the Superintendent or the Superintendent's designee.

DECLARATION OF RESIDENCE

This form should be completed by any parent, guardian, or unaccompanied student requesting enrollment in an Adams 12 Five Star School who cannot provide proof of residence (in their own name) within the established school attendance boundaries. Complete one form per family and provide proofs of residence. This form is valid until student(s) enter middle or high school or a change of residence occurs. If a change of residence occurs, please notify your school.

*NOTE: The following information is requested to satisfy federal record keeping requirements. It will not be used to deny enrollment and may be used to assure student/family enrollment rights. WARNING
