Adams 12 taking names for new school

Deadline is Aug. 18 to submit proposals

As a new PreK-8 school takes shape in Broomfield's Anthem neighborhood, Adams 12 Five Star Schools is inviting the public to help pick a name and mascot.

The campus, at 3461 Pre-

ble Creek Parkway, is scheduled to open in the fall of 2018.

Currently, construction crews are pouring concrete foundation walls, installing storm piping and water, constructing 45-foot stair towers, working on gym masonry wall, underground

plumbing and electric on the east end of the building and installing geothermal headers in the parking lot, according to the district's website.

The school is designed to be net-zero energy, which means in theory the total amount of energy used by the building is roughly equal to the amount of renewable energy created on site.

District officials encourage feedback from students, staff, parents and communi-

ty members during the school naming process.

According to district policy, acceptable school and facility names must meet certain criteria for consideration. Facility names for school buildings shall not be the:

- Name of a community, city or subdivision within which the facility is located.
- Same name as another public school in the metro-Denver area.
- Name of an individual,

whether deceased or living, except for facilities named for an individual prior to adoption of this policy.

Possible school name and mascot suggestions can relate to the history of the area where the school is being constructed or the natural environment of the community surrounding the school, the city or state including topographic features or native wildlife.

Suggestions will be accepted through 4:30 p.m. Aug. 18.
