Available to all high school students in the Five Star District, CTE courses combine rigorous academics with technical skills in hands-on learning environments. CTE programs partner with businesses, industry leaders and post-secondary institutions to provide opportunities for students to succeed in both the workforce and higher education in a wide range of in-demand careers with competitive salaries.

Since 2012, 25 percent of students interested in enrolling in CTE courses were turned away due to lack of space. With the passing of the 2016 bond, 80% more students across the district will have the chance to participate in CTE opportunities.
