I have an MA degree and an endorsement in Culturally and Linguistically Diverse Education from the Colorado Department of Education (CDE) or another state. Do I need to take the Adams 12 Supporting ELLs Training: Part I and Part II?

Yes, the Adams 12 Supporting ELLs Training: Part I and Part II incorporates elements of the basic foundational knowledge to effectively support ELLs but it also includes aspects of identification, placement, redesignation, monitoring, and data collection, ELD supports in content areas, etc. that are specific to Adams 12.

I took the former Basic ELL Training in the past but I received an email about registration to take it this year. How can we correct the district records?

Please send us a copy of the past completed Basic or Advanced training(s) certificate or transcript and a correction will be processed.

The communication about the Adams 12 Supporting ELLs Training: Part I indicates five (5) sessions. Do I need to attend all five sessions?

No, please register only for one session. Five options are provided so participants have choices. You need only to register and attend one of the five options.

I was in the district in 2002-2004 and completed an ELL training. Do I need to take the training again?

No, please send us all supporting documentation of completion and a correction will be made in our records. (certificate of completion, transcripts, email communication from/to the ESL/LASS/ELL Department, etc.).

I have completed SIOP training in another district. Do I need to take the Adams 12 Supporting ELLs Training: Part I and Part II?

No, it is urgent that all Adams 12 teachers have the tools and information to support English language learners (ELLs) in content and language development. All teachers new to the district are required to complete the Part I training one year from the date of hire.

I am new to Adams 12 and I want to complete both Part I and Part II during my first year, can I complete both sessions this year?

Yes. Please contact Nelson Molina at nelson.molina@adams12.org for approval. You could complete both sessions during the first year in Adams 12. However, please keep in mind that other trainings could take place for other content areas and it could be overwhelming for a new educator and his/her students when considering the impact of being out of the classroom too often.
