

**ADAMS 12 FIVE STAR SCHOOLS
RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COLLECTION OF FEES
FOR THE 2015-2016 SCHOOL YEAR**

WHEREAS, the Adams 12 Five Star Schools annual budget for the fiscal year 2015-2016 is being contemporaneously adopted following two public meetings held after duly published public notices; and

WHEREAS, Colorado Revised Statutes § 22-32-110 and § 22-32-117 authorize the Board of Education to require pupils to pay fees necessary for and reasonably related to the actual cost of textbooks and expendable supplies; and

WHEREAS, the fiscal year 2015-2016 adopted budget includes revenues and expenditures attributable to the collection of textbook, instructional materials and technology fees, as well as miscellaneous fees developed pursuant to Superintendent Policy 5630; and

WHEREAS, the imposition of such fees continues to be necessary for the operation of the District;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Education of Adams 12 Five Star Schools:

THAT, the collection of textbook, instructional materials and technology fees, in addition to the types of fees implemented pursuant to Superintendent Policy 5630, are approved and authorized and listed on the attached current schedule, which may be amended from time to time in accordance with said policy; and

THAT, all revenue from collected fees shall be used for the purpose stated in the fee schedule; and

THAT, a transportation fee shall no longer be collected; and

THAT, the textbook, instructional materials and technology fees shall be waived for any pupil who is eligible for a free or reduced-price meal under the National School Lunch Act, 42 § U.S.C. 1751, *et seq.*; and

THAT, the Superintendent, in his discretion, is authorized to waive fees above and beyond the waiver of textbook, instructional materials and technology fees for pupils eligible for a free or reduced-price meal under the National School Lunch Act.
