Dear Oil and Gas Operator,

I am writing today to request your assistance. Adams 12 Five Star Schools is working to ensure the safety of our students and staff in the district's schools.

Given the recent house explosion in Firestone and other issues about oil and gas wells in the state of Colorado, we are concerned that standard environmental due diligence for school sites is no longer sufficient to ensure the safety of our students and staff. According to public records, your company is the owner/operator of record for 1 well(s) within 2,000 feet of an Adams 12 school site.

We request all information, reports, findings etc. for all the wells (listed in appendix A) located within 2,000 feet of an Adams 12 school facility from the May 2, 2017 notice to operators statewide.

Thank you for your assistance. We very much appreciate you understanding the serious nature of school safety, especially in light of the recent events and concerns about oil and gas wells in our state. Kindly provide the requested information within 30 days of this letter so we are well prepared for the beginning of the 2017-18 school year in August.
