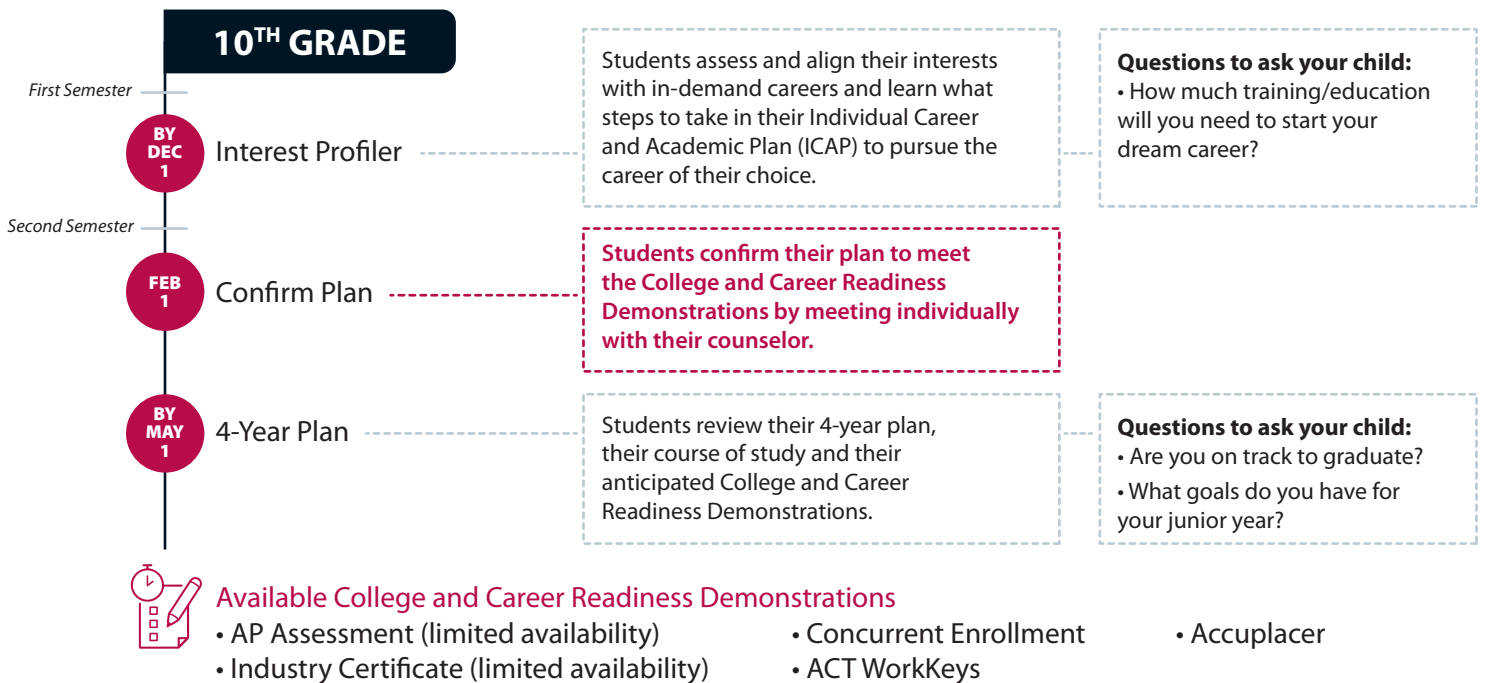
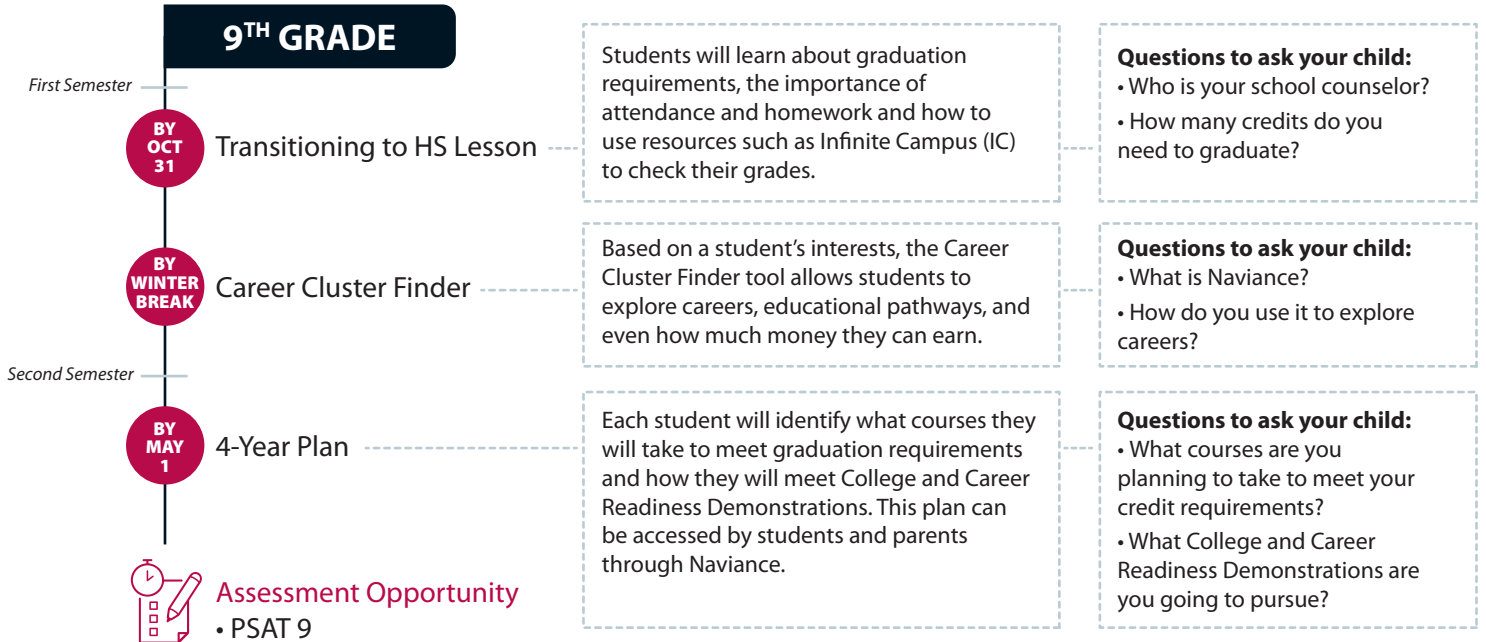


High School Counseling Timeline
