**a) People Resources:**

- i) Security

**b) Technology We Use**

- i) Raptor – visitor screening system
- ii) Aiphone – visitor access and pre screening
- iii) Card Access - building access management through programmable locked doors
- iv) Video Surveillance – video monitoring of exterior and interior area of buildings
- v) Lockdown buttons
- vi) Lockout buttons

**c) Technology Updates Needed:**

- i) 614 analog cameras need to be updated to IP cameras
- ii) 29 camera DVR’s need to be updated by year 2020
- iii) Bi-Directional Amplified Antenna updates to accommodate narrow banding
