Agenda

The night will include a presentation from district staff and the opportunity to engage in table conversations about the following current social-emotional learning and safety measures that are ongoing in the Five Star District:

Social-emotional learning - including districtwide social-emotional curriculum by level and staff who support the social-emotional well-being of all students.

Crisis response and recovery - including staff and roles, and how we provide support to students, schools and families during and after a crisis situation.

Mental health supports for students and families - including suicide awareness and assessment, mental health supports at the district and school level, and community partnerships.

Prevention initiatives to create safe and supportive schools - including bullying prevention efforts and work towards being a trauma-informed district.

Parent partnership - your role and how you can support the social-emotional well-being of all students.

There will be an opportunity in the meeting to ask additional questions you may have.
